



# 40 Hour HazMat Technician's Course

After completing the course, participants will be able to:

- Select the appropriate personal protective equipment for responding to an incident involving hazardous materials.
- Use monitoring equipment to evaluate the hazards present at a hazardous materials incident.
- Use confinement and containment techniques to control the release of a hazardous material.
- Identify the importance of an incident command system for effectively managing an incident involving hazardous materials.
- Develop procedures for the decontamination of emergency response personnel.
- Use size-up techniques to develop strategies and select the appropriate tactics for mitigating hazardous material incidents.

<b>Prerequisite:</b>	To attend this course, you will need a medical evaluation in accordance with the <b>Respiratory Protection Standard, 29 CFR 1910.134</b> . This is necessary in order to attend this course. Each student <b>MUST</b> have a letter from their supervisor OR a copy of a medical certificate that clearly states that a medical evaluation has been completed and that the student is medically able to wear respiratory protection equipment.
