Course Description: The goal of the course is to provide state and local emergency management officials with the knowledge and skills they need to operate an Emergency Operating Center (EOC) and interface it with an Incident Command System (ICS) field operation. The course provides an opportunity for participants to begin developing an ICS/EOC interface for their community. The course reviews ICS and EOC responsibilities and functions and depends heavily on exercise and group discussions to formulate the interface.

Prerequisites: Recommended: ISO100.b, Introduction to the Incident Command System, ICS 100; ISO200.b, Incident Command System for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents; and/or EOC Management courses.
