Resource Management

 Resource management includes concepts such as typing, inventorying, organizing and tracking, to assist with the dispatch, deployment and recovery of resources.







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Resource Typing

Resource typing is categorizing, by capability, the resources requested, deployed and used in incidents.





Resource Typing

 Allows emergency responders to know the expected capabilities a piece of equipment needs to have to respond efficiently and effectively.





Resource Typing

- The 120 Typed Assets are organized into:
 - Category: Function
 - Kind: Teams, Personnel, Equipment and supplies
 - Type: measures the minimum capabilities to perform a function.





Resource Typing

- All resources are **Type I** and up.
 - Type I implies a higher capability than Type II.
 - Equipment is typed based on its lowest capability.
 - Teams are typed and defined using equipment, personnel and training.
