

PARISH ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT CHECKLIST needed for PRESIDENTIAL DISASTER DECLARATION

It is required that an *Economic Impact Statement* be included in the Governor's request for a **Presidential declaration**. This checklist is intended as a **guide** for parish emergency management officials to collect and provide the needed information to the **Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP)**.

- Describe impacted area.
- List of damaged public + private structures.
- Demographic groups impacted.
 - Minorities.
 - Uninsured + under-insured.
 - Elderly.
 - Special needs.
 - Other under-served populations.
- Public + private revenue impacts.
 - **Public**
 - ❖ Anticipated loss/reduction of sales + income tax revenues.
 - ❖ Anticipated loss/reduction of property tax revenues.
 - ❖ Anticipated loss/reduction in event revenues + facility rentals + other.
 - **Private**
 - ❖ Individual
 - Anticipated loss/reduction in individual income.
 - ❖ Business
 - Anticipated loss/reduction in transactions (business income).
 - **Nonprofit**
 - Anticipated loss/reduction in revenue stream.
 - **Other**

PARISH ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT CHECKLIST needed for PRESIDENTIAL DISASTER DECLARATION

Evacuation data.

- Area.
- Type of evacuation order.
- Number of individuals evacuated.
- Duration of evacuation.
- Number of shelters open.
- Number of individuals served.
- Length of time shelters open.
- Number of meals served.

Other business impacts.

- Import/export interruption.
- Business closures.

Employment impacts.

- Number of people out of work
 - ❖ For how long.

Infrastructure impacts.

- Critical infrastructure.
 - ❖ Each parish has a list.
- Other infrastructure.
- Cascading effects of impacted infrastructure.
 - ❖ Within the disaster area.
 - ❖ Outside of the disaster area.

Other impacts.

- School closures.
- Utility disruptions.
- Road closures.
- Deaths and injuries.
- Other.

If possible, provide Geographic Information System (GIS) data and visual images of damaged areas.
