GOHSEP UPDATE

James Waskom

- Director Waskom gave a brief overview on the repeal and replacement of the current Louisiana EMAC law. He also advised that legislators are considering a new bill to establish an emergency management assistance trust fund, which would add an additional fee to homeowner's and commercial insurance policies.

State exercise and Louisiana National Guard DRX

- The State Exercise is a command post exercise to test items such as communications, WebEOC, emergency operation center procedures, and coordination with parishes with no field activity.
- The LANG DRX is a full scale exercise will field operations in several parishes.

Point to Point Agreement (P2P)

- Chris and Sandy lead discussion regarding point to point shelter agreements for critical transportation needs shelters (CTNS) and explained that Union Parish has availability for 200 people. Calcasieu Parish evacuation needs still being worked. Jefferson Parish seeking P2P location.

Grambling State University could be a sheltering option, but GOHSEP is working on issues with new administration and building ownership.
