III. Approval of Minutes

A. Ellis Boothe made a motion to approve the February 19, 2025 and April 30, 2025 meeting minutes as presented. Billie Mertz seconded the motion. The SIEC voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the October 23, 2024 meeting.

IV. Chairman's Report

- A. Chairman Euclid Talley began by thanking the members for attending the meeting.
- B. Interoperability Program Manager, Jake Chatfield updated the board on the status of the states Motorola contract. Also, updated the committee on the recent Commercial Carriers Group meeting and COMEX Green Wizard.
- C. Statewide System Maintenance Report Fefe Franklin with the DPS Radio Communications Section provided detailed information about the LWIN system. This presentation is available on the SIEC Website under the Meeting Minutes link.

II. Unfinished Business

- A. Julio Peck from LSP discussed the status of the Ethernet Project was going along with the updated timeline. This presentation is available on the SIEC Website under the Meeting Minutes link.
- B. Jake Chatfield discussed the status of Youngsville tower site, and inquired what is pending for the site. Bill Vincent detailed the site needs of a generator and building for equipment followed by a motion to fully fund the entire project, and demanded immediate vote from the SIEC Board. When asked for any financial documentation for the project Bill Vincent was unable to provide any documentation, but still demanded a vote. Subsequent discussion lead to a substitutionary motion by Bobby Moore to table the motion until the board had more financial information along with documentation from Motorola. Conrad Baker second the motion by Bobby Moore and the vote was passed with 01 Nay vote from the board.

III. New Business

A. Euclid Talley discussed Governor's Landry GUMBO 2.0 that allows. Distributions of \$1.35 billion in funding to support broadband access throughout the state. Detailing the initiative will expand broadband services into rural areas and eliminating the digital divide in the state. Euclid encouraged board members to volunteer for the Broadband Subcommittee.

- B. Jake Chatfield presented the list of SIEC Subcommittee members and request volunteers for each subcommittee. Discussed the subcommittees will be holding more regular meetings than in the past.
- C. Jake Chatfield discussed the recent fiber outages that have caused large scale outages. Jake Chatfield asked for suggestions from the board on what they are doing to back up their communication systems, and asked what issues the regions have been experiencing.
- D. Aaron Richards from BEARCOM detailed the status of Houma tower site. Houma has decided to build on the Houma Sheriff Office property, and they have agreed on the tower design. Houma is paying for the entire project.

IV. Public Comments

Chief of Bossier City Police, and the Fire Chief of Bossier City requested an official coverage tests done for the entire parish due to a lack of coverage from the LWIN towers in that area. They detailed the technical issues they have with their emergency services responding to incidents and not having the appropriate radio coverage to safely conduct the mission. LSP has taken note and will send a team up there immediately to conduct a parish wide coverage assessment.

V. Next Quarterly Meeting

Chairman Euclid Talley advised the committee that without objection, the next quarterly meeting of the SIEC would be October 22, 2024 at 1:30 PM, in person at the GOHSEP's EOC. There were no objections.

VI. Adjournment

Ellis Boothe made a motion to adjourn. The SIEC voted unanimously to adjourn at 2:50 pm.
