LEPA 2018 Conference Cancellation/Refund Policy

If a registrant is unable to attend an event for any reason they may substitute, by arrangement with the registrar, someone else from the same institute/organization.

Where the registrant is unable to attend, and is not in a position to transfer his/her place to another person, then the following refund arrangements apply:

Registrations cancelled more than 30 days before the event will be refunded 80% of the registration fees.

Registrations cancelled less than 30 but more than 15 days before the event will be refunded 50% of the registration fees.

Registrations cancelled less than 15 days before the event will <u>not</u> be eligible for a refund. Registrations cancelled due to a declared state of emergency within their jurisdiction are eligible for a refund less a \$15 processing fee. Registrants will need to provide a copy of the declared state of emergency to the LEPA office.

Emergency Illness or Death of Registrant or Immediate Family Member

Refunds may be granted if an attendee is unable to attend the conference due to a family death, illness, or other extraordinary circumstance approved by the LEPA board of directors. In such a circumstance, the Main Office must be contacted by phone, letter or e-mail. If initial notification is by phone, it must be followed up in writing within 15 days. Refunds will still be subject to the \$15 processing fee and the membership fee will be retained for those non-member registrations.

No Show Policy

Refunds will not be granted for no-shows (registrants who do not attend the conference with no prior notice of cancellation). Delegates assume full responsibility for notification to and verification of receipt by the

LEPA office.

Refunds will be made in the following ways

For payments received by credit or debit cards, the same credit/debit card will be refunded. For all other payments, a bank check will be made to the payee.

Lessons Learned from the Response to the November 2015 Terrorist Attacks in Paris

Abigail Williams
Office of Intelligence and Analysis
Department of Homeland Security

This presentation will discuss lessons learned by Parisian officials who responded to the 13 November 2015 attacks in Paris, France including critical challenges officials faced, how they adapted to changing conditions on the ground, and why this incident still matters.

Abigail Williams joined the Department of Homeland Security/Office of Intelligence in 2012. She is currently assigned the Homeland Threats Division's unit focused on terrorist tactics and targets and serves as the lead analyst for suspicious activity reporting. She previously worked for the Federal Bureau of Investigation as an intelligence analyst in the Counterterrorism Division. Prior to her federal service she worked in civil aviation.

An Overview of School Safety Best Practices

Research shows efforts by parents, administrators, teachers, students, first responders, emergency managers, and community members can reduce safety concerns and improve the overall school environment. One of the key concerns for many is stopping school violence. This requires multiple prevention/ mitigation strategies addressed by schools with their communities' First Responders.



Prevention efforts reduce risk factors and help organizations effectively respond to acts of violence within a school district. This session will review prevention/mitigation measures and practices within St. Charles Parish Public Schools to assist in building a safety culture throughout the school system.
