Key Point from PowerPoint:

- A new draft version of the Louisiana Unified Shelter Plan will be rolled out for the parishes to review.
- What can and cannot be done by agencies?
 - a) What to expect from the Parish, Red Cross and GOHSEP

- b) You have to be able to shelter your people by law 6.8% of the people.
Population estimates: 20% of the total parish population and using 6.8% of that population for planning assumptions.
- c) Red Cross will be doing outreach over the next couple of weeks with the parishes to go over the plan and review assets within parishes and regions.
- d) Be prepared to rescue for 24 hours
- e) Timeline for Implantation- Who is responsible

Lesson Learned

Round Table Decision Topics

- GOHSEP has spots available to preposition in parishes if you are interested, get with your regional coordinator for details.
- Consider using CERT teams for shelter operations and think about creating a marine response team in your parish to help with high water rescues.
- How to bridge the GAP between Red Cross and Parishes
- Knowing the difference between a IMAC request and a WebEOC request. IMAC request can be between parishes. WebEOC is a request to GOHSEP.
