

Public Assistance – Debris Removal

This course provides a practical, planning-focused overview of Public Assistance and Debris Removal, emphasizing the actions communities must take before and after disasters to ensure safe operations and successful reimbursement.

Participants will learn how debris removal is coordinated across local, state, and federal partners; how procurement, contracting, and documentation decisions affect eligibility; and how environmental and historic preservation requirements influence debris operations.

By the end of the course, participants will leave with a functional understanding of public assistance and a foundational debris management framework for community efficiency and statewide resiliency.
