III. Approval of Minutes

IV. Chairman's Report

- A. Chairman Jake Chatfield began by thanking the members for attending the meeting.
- B. Interoperability Program Manager, Jake Chatfield updated the board on Hurricane Francine' response updates. Facilitated power outages and recovery with commercial carriers that effected approximately 130 cellular towers the first night. This collaboration allowed power companies to prioritize grids to bring cellular and LWIN towers back online in a timely manner. Also, briefed that the Hazardous Mitigation Grant Project was in the final phase of approval with FEMA.
- C. Statewide System Maintenance Report Ravi Penumarthi with the DPS Radio Communications Section provided detailed information about the LWIN system. This presentation is available on the SIEC Website under the Meeting Minutes link.

Billie Giroir discussed the approval of several new LWIN Tower projects for South Livingston, Morehouse, Zachary, Concordia, Avoyelles East, Bossier City, and Thibodeaux.

Billie detailed the coverage issues for Iberville, and future tests going forward. Billie also discussed Region 2 requests a bank of 16 talkgroups. Discussed the Statewide SSID's for Smart Connect. Any requests will go directly thru MCS. Bill Vincent made the motion, and Richard McGuire 2nd the motion.

- C. Avoyelles Tower was discussed more in depth from the Technical Subcommittee.
