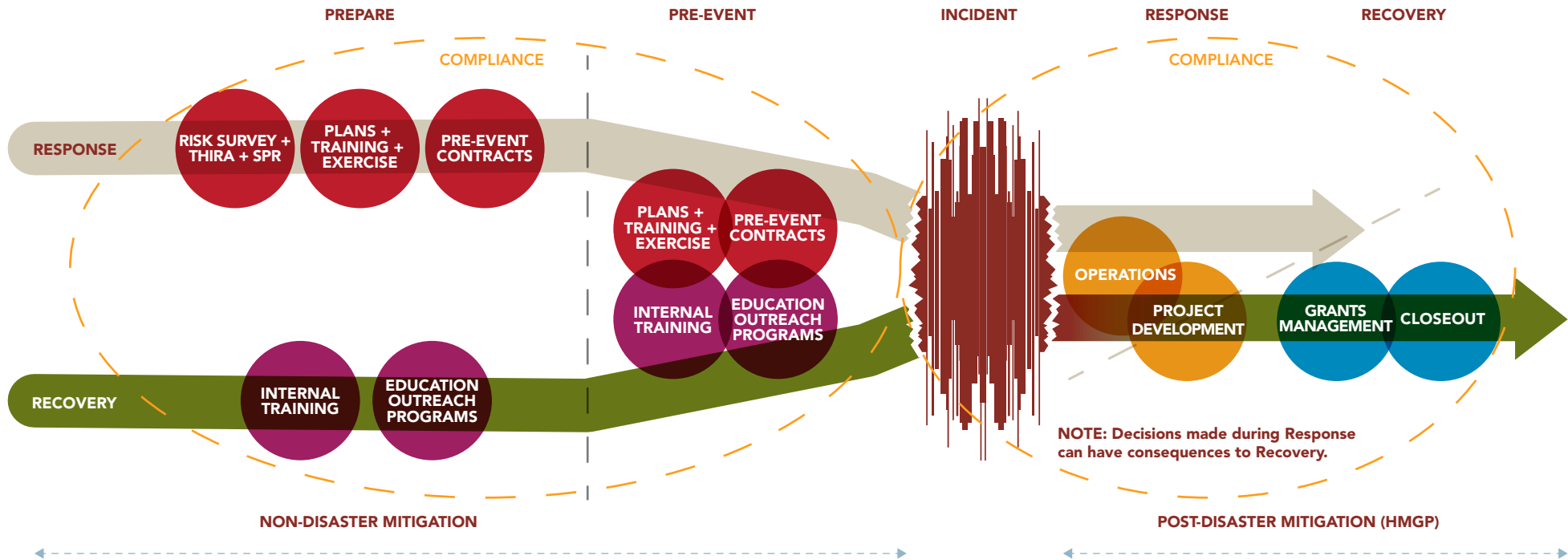

 HMGP – Hazard Mitigation Grant Program — available post-disaster.

Risk Survey – A series of questions that, when completed, identify risk and the capability to respond to that risk. The Risk Survey informs the development of a Risk Assessment, State Preparedness Report (SPR) and National Incident Management System (NIMS) Compliance Report.

Threat + Hazard Identification + Risk Assessment (THIRA) – THIRA is based on the analysis of State Hazard Mitigation Plans, historical occurrences, Presidential disaster declarations and general threat assessments. It provides a comprehensive approach for identifying risks and their associated impacts through the lens of the 31 Core Capabilities identified by U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and defined in the National Preparedness Goal (NPG).

State Preparedness Report (SPR) – Assesses current preparedness levels against Capability Targets set in the THIRA.
