

# Evacuation, Sheltering, and Re-entry

This course will enhance community planning, preparedness, and participation for effective evacuation of citizens during a crisis incident.

Participants will take a comprehensive walkthrough of transportation, evacuation, sheltering, and returning home.

ESF leads and subject-matter experts will guide participants through the following evacuation topics: parish pickup points, transportation coordination and screening, emergency triage, unified shelter plans and shelter types, mass care levels, related services, and returning home.

By the end of the course, students will understand response target capabilities for state assisted evacuation.
